



Hope in the Resurrection

1 Peter 3:18-22 ¹⁸ For Christ also died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit; ¹⁹ in which he went and preached to the spirits in prison, ²⁰ who formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, during the building of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were saved through water. ²¹ Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, ²² who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers subject to him.

This year we have an extra reason to celebrate on Easter. Tyler Loburk will be the first baptism that we have had on Easter Sunday. What a fitting time to be baptized! In baptism, we are united with Christ, as Saint Paul says in Romans:

Romans 6:3-5 ³ Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴ We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵ For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.

This year, as we once again celebrate the resurrection, we also get to celebrate with Tyler and his family. As the congregation, we are also reminded that in our own baptisms we too have been united with Christ. This means that we too will share in the resurrection. Our celebration on Easter is a celebration of what God has already done, but by celebrating a baptism as well as resurrection we are also celebrating what God is doing now, and what God will do in the future!

I look forward to seeing you all on Easter and having a spectacular day of celebration, both for our congregation and for Tyler and his family.
