

We are officially done with the first 6 months of the year. This has so far been a great year for us. God has blessed us with 17 new members this year (8 adults, 9 children) and continues to bless us with visitors. On top of that, our financial giving has significantly increased over last year. Our average attendance for the first 6 months of 2011 was 52/Sunday. This year, we are averaging close to 60/Sunday, with our largest attendance coming on Easter Sunday, when we had 107 at worship.

As for giving, the first 6 months of 2011 averaged \$7480/month. For 2012, our average giving for the first 6 months was \$7975/month. That is a significant increase and helps us tremendously with meeting our spending plan. However, we are still running in the red each month. The \$500/month increase over last year doesn't sound like much, but in the course of 12 months it is huge!

While all these numbers look great, we still have a lot of work to do. July is coming to a close and these next five months will be crucial for us as we look to continue this upward trend. We all pray that God will continue keeping us on this path and that our participation will help benefit our congregation as a whole.
